The data show that *JZUS (A&B)*'s SCI citation records trend upwards annually, total cited times 686 from 2000 to Oct. 24, 2007.

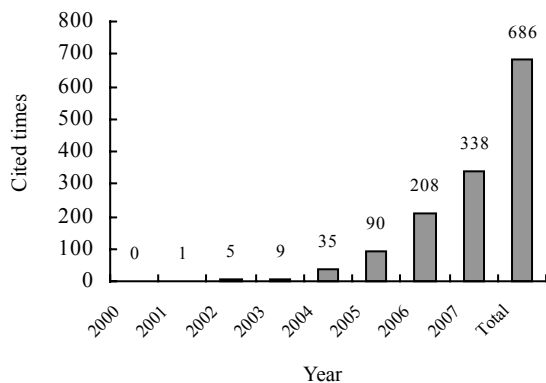


Fig.1 *JZUS (A&B)* annual and total SCI cited records

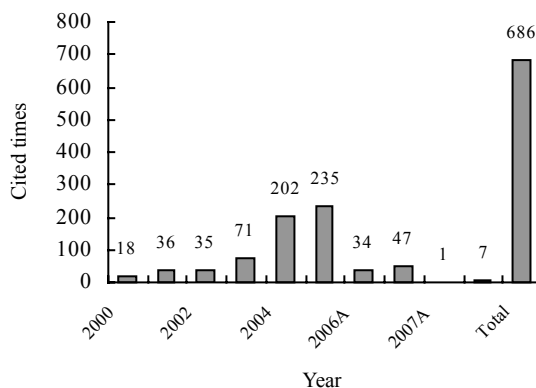


Fig.2 SCI cited annual records of *JZUS (A&B)* articles

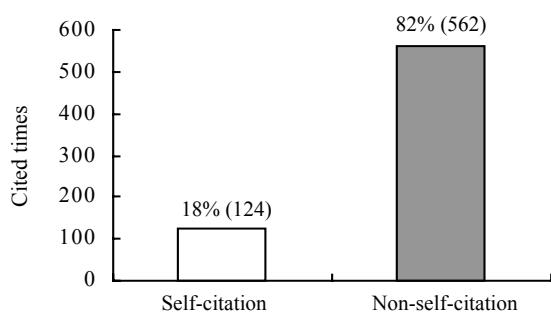


Fig.3 Comparative records between author self-citation and non-self-citation

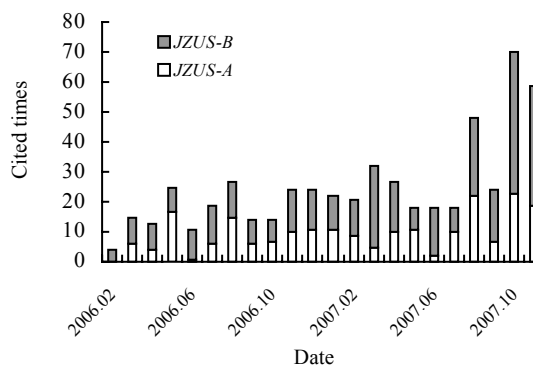


Fig.4 Monthly SCI citation records of *JZUS (A&B)* from Jan. 15, 2006 to Oct. 24, 2007
